CAMPERSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Northville Parks & Recreation is partnering with The Kids Table to offer campership opportunities to help make our youth summer day camps more accessible to families in need of financial assistance. We are committed to ensuring that every child has the opportunity to experience the enrichment, fun, and personal growth that our camp programs provide.

Camperships will be awarded based on demonstrated financial need and the availability of funding. Assistance is available exclusively for Camp Crowside, Maybury Nature Camp, and Safety Town. Please note that additional program fees, transportation, and personal items are the responsibility of the family.

Northville Parks & Recreation reserves the right to rescind a campership if any information provided in the application is found to be false or misleading.

Eligibility Requirements

Please review the following information to see if your family meets the requirements for the camperships. The applicant must:

- Reside in Northville or the surrounding community
- Submit proof of household income (Form 1040 preferred or other accepted documentation)
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher, doctor, or social worker
- Submit proof of residency
- Fully complete the Campership Application

Application must include a signature. Applicants must be 18 or older to sign. If under 18, a parent or guardian signature is required.

Failure to provide the information above, including a signature, will result in the application being considered as incomplete. Any incomplete applications will not be reviewed and will not be considered for the campership opportunity.

Submission and Review Process

Completed campership applications may be submitted in person at the Northville Parks & Recreation office or via email to recreation@northvilletownshipmi.gov.

All applications will be reviewed by the Recreation Specialist or Recreation Superintendent. Applicants will be notified of the decision once the review process is complete. Please note that submitting an application does **not guarantee** a campership award. Only fully completed applications will be considered.

Each applicant may request campership assistance for **up to two weeks of camp per summer**. Preference will be given to **first-time applicants** who have not previously received campership support.
